PEER SUPPORT/SPECIAL OLYMPICS COORDINATOR

NEW BUSINESS:

CA GROUP MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Board will reimburse CA Group \$500 for each individual that moves to a higher level of employment. If the individual moves two levels the payment will be \$1,000 and if the individual moves three levels it will be \$1,500. This is in Article 1 section A of memorandum. Will try this with CA Group for a year to entice them to move individuals with disabilities along path of employment. Next year may try this with other providers. This will be an

incentive for CA Group. Will look at this again in November. A motion was made to approve this Memorandum of Understanding by <u>Beth Guggenbiller</u> and a second by <u>Jim Maurer</u>. Motion was carried.

MERCER COUNTY ESC BUILDING SPACE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

We will allow the ESC electronic access and custodial care and general maintenance to occupied space. The plan for the ESC for next year is to expand with an option for an Alternative School. We do not have more room for them so they will need to repurpose existing space. Right now they are using four classrooms and two rooms off of the gym. Sharing space has gone well this year. **Motion was made to approve the renewal of the MCESC Memorandum by <u>Teri Spoltman</u> and a second by <u>Deb Hecht. Motion was carried.</u>**

MERCER COUNTY ESC CONTRACT

\$121,000 is contracted to ESC each year to help offset the cost of educating children with delays and disabilities. We receive a bill from the ESC two times a year.

Motion was made to approve the ESC Contract by <u>Jim Maurer</u> and a second by <u>Mona Berning</u>. <u>Motion was carried</u>.

2018 ANNUAL REPORT

The annual report for 2018 was recently completed. Shawn went thru this report with the Board. Last year there were 144 served in EI and this year we have served 176. 98% are served in the home. Shawn reported that we have secured \$350,000 for purchase of Arc homes and we are close to adding another home in Celina. Level One Waiver #'s have risen from 92 last year to 106 in 2019.

SHELTERED WORKSHOP BUILDING DISCUSSION

Shawn gave an update on the sheltered workshop building. Foundations asked to use that building for their summer program. It is not going to work this year. Commissioners are looking at moving the Agriculture Offices into workshop building.

REPLACEMENT OF 2006 TRUCK

The Board discussed replacing the 2006 truck. Chris Sauer uses it a lot for projects and to plow snow. The back bumper recently fell off of truck, the check engine light has been on, and the headliner is collapsing. Proposal estimate is \$31,000 for a 2018 and will get \$6,500 for trade in. It will take \$1,500 to get it suited for a snow plow. Motion was made to approve the purchase of a truck at an estimated price of \$25,000.00 by Mona Berning and a second by Teri Spoltman. Motion was carried.

Motion was made to adjourn by <u>Mona Berning</u> and a second by <u>Jim Maurer</u>. Motion was carried. Meeting adjourned.
