## **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Home Visiting Positions**—The part time position has been filled. Kate Scott will start on 4/9. She lives in New Bremen. She is a part time physical therapist/home health care. We are now fully staffed in the Help Me Grow Home Visitor Department.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

**Human Rights Committee**—Went over this yearly report. If an ISP has any restrictive measure or anything that might take away the rights from that person, it must go before the Human Rights Committee. We go through a process, we consult with Dynamic Pathways first., They help us with restrictive measures—we always try positive interventions. Then it goes to Human Rights Committee. They meet every other month. Mona is on this committee. The board thanked Mona for being on the committee.

Transition Services/Summer Program—Went over the number of people coming from EI. How we determine eligibility when they are 6 and also when they turn 16. We use the Ohio Eligibility Determination Instrument (OEDI) and the Childrens Ohio Eligibility Instrument (COEDI). This way we can start making long range plans for services that will be needed. We are also working on the Summer Program. The numbers are down a little bit. Karen L has retired. Jessica Baltes is meeting with families that will be involved. There will be no changes this year to the summer program.

**Special Olympics**—We have started a new Equestrian Program. This is a very remarkable thing to have. We will be competing in different styles, Western, Dressage, etc. We will be competing in Findlay. We will have the horses and the partners there competing. This is a very emotion filled program. We are practicing at the Circle T Ranch. Sam will come to a board meeting and give an update. The board is very impressed by everything that Sam has accomplished with the Special Olympics Program.

The project behind the building is coming along great. They will be pouring concrete this week. There will be a bocce ball/pickleball, basketball courts and a putting green. This will give our athletes many more opportunities.
